Home to four different mangrove species, the dense foliage and interconnected roots of trees provide a beautiful haven for plants and animals. Spot mangrove snakes, kingfishers and monitor lizards as you journey through Sebung River on a speedboat.

For another extraordinary experience, sign up for the Mangrove Discovery Night Tour that departs daily at 7:30pm. Unlike in the day, the mangrove is serene and peaceful; the rippled river glistens under the moonlight. Be awed by the intermittent yet enchanting glow of dancing fireflies under a blanket of dazzling night stars.

Mangrove Replanting

Mangrove trees along the coasts of Bintan is one of the key components of Bintan Island's coastal ecosystem. Mangrove roots filter and block sediments from unstable substrates of the upstream rivers and land, preventing siltation of seagrass beds and coral reefs.

In 2007, a mangrove nursery which grew a selection of local mangrove species was set up. Ever since, over $18,000 \, \text{m}^2$ of mangrove area has been restored. This translates into more than $28,000 \, \text{new}$ saplings along Sebung River, offsetting $1.8 \, \text{metric}$ tonnes of carbon per uear.

Currently, the mangrove nursery is being managed by the community of Sebung Lagoi, together with a village business foundation.







3 Pujasera Food Centre

Just a short five minutes' drive from Bandar Bentan Telani Ferry Terminal is Pujasera Food Centre. Indulge in mouth-watering local delights, such as Ayam Penyet, Nasi Goreng, Soto Ayam and many more Bintan favourites. Here you can rub shoulders with locals in a comfortable neighbourhood coffee shop setting.

Provision shops near the food centre are stocked with snacks if you are feeling peckish for a late night supper. They also carry daily necessities, and data SIM cards for your convenience.

Safari Lagoi

Set out on an incredible adventure at Safari Lagoi and Eco Farm. Home to rescued and endangered wildlife, this tour lets you come face to face

with residents such as orangutans, Komodo dragons, tigers, sun bears, elephants and even a 6-metre crocodile!

Turtle Conservation Efforts

Turtle conservation was started by Bintan Resorts in 2004. Since then, Bintan Resorts has been working closely with the resorts and local community to save nesting hawksbill turtles in North Bintan.

During the nesting season, eggs are collected and kept safely in a covered hatchery located at various resorts. More than 4,500 hatchlings have been released and egg poaching by local villagers was reduced from 91% in 2004 to 12% in 2010.



Seasonal hawksbill hatcheries can be found in Nirwana Gardens, Angsana Bintan, Banyan Tree Bintan, and Club Med Bintan. All releases can be followed for free. Please contact your resort for further information on release dates.

East Bintan

Must Experience







Take in the breathtaking views of the **Trikora Coast** lined with kelongs (floating fishing platforms), wooden huts and traditional boat builders. Trikora's four beaches each lead into crystal clear waters.

The beaches are a popular hide-out for locals on the weekends. Families gather along the huts dotting the coastline to soak in the sea breeze. You can even spot local boat makers building wooden fishing boats by hand.

2

Panglong Village, Berakit

At the eastern tip of Bintan lies **Panglong Village**, home to the largest community of sea gypsies in Bintan. Commonly referred to as Orang Laut, they are sea nomads who dedicate their lives at sea. Discover their unique way of life, carried down for generations over hundreds of years.

Spend an afternoon in **Panglong Village** and soak in the simplicity of life. The labyrinth of stilt houses offers a peek into local lifestyle and traditions.



Spot fishermen returning from the sea with their catch, fixing their nets in the comforts of their front yards or drying seafood in the open.





3 Grotto Santa Maria



A mere 20 minutes away from the pearly sands of Trikora Coast, lies a serene pilgrimage spot known as the **Grotto Santa Maria**. Grotto Santa Maria depicts the story of Jesus Christ's crucifixion with the '14 Stations of the Cross' made of limestone, leading up to a statue of Virgin Mary in a cave. The chapel at the end of the trail comes to life on Sundays when devotees gather with song and prayer.

4 Kawal

Keep a lookout for **Kawal**, a sleepy village and local fishery. Experience the rustic and slow-paced life similar to **Panglong Village** in Berakit. The endless floating platforms or kelongs, that are docked near the coast is a definite sight to behold.



Must Eat

Pizza Casa Italia





Hidden along **Trikora Coast** is a traditional Italian family-run pizzeria, **Pizza Casa Italia**, serving pizza fresh from a wood-fired stone oven flown in from Italy.

With the gooiest cheese and crunchiest thin crust, Pizza Casa Italia even serves up localised flavours such as Pizza Cornet (corned beef), Jagung (corn) and Pizza Sarden (sardines).



Otak-otak stalls

An addictive street snack, otak-otak, is commonly found all over Bintan. Otak-otak is a simple snack made from a slab of prawn, squid or fish paste marinated with spices such as lemongrass and lime, wrapped in banana or coconut leaves. Grilled over charcoal flames, the result is a delectable, lip-smacking treat with a burst of flavors. Cast your verdict on the otak-otak by trying out the street stalls near **Kawal** at the southern end of **Trikora Coast**.







3 Local Seafood

The French has the escargot, Bintan has the Gong Gong. Gong Gong is a type of sea snail found in the waters around Bintan Island. Usually boiled to perfection, its meat can be taken out from its shell with a tooth pick and dipped in delectable sauces. Take your taste buds on an adventure and try out other forms of local seafood such as *Remis* or *Ikan Bakar* at a coastal seafood restaurant such as the **Telok Bakau Bay View Restaurant**.

Day Trip Options





White Sands Island, also known as Pulau Beralas Pasir, is a private island located 15 minutes from Trikora Coast by boat.

The island is perfect for a day trip to a private haven with a line-up of exciting programs customised for holiday-makers. Explore deep blue Bintan with snorkelling and scuba diving trips or courses by Sunfish Cove. Other activities such as beach soccer, volleyball, kite flying and Frisbee make for plenty of fun in the sun.





The island also actively takes part in conservation for baby turtles. On top of a turtle sanctuary, Save Our Seas, an annual seabed and beach clean up event is also held with the support of volunteer divers, nearby resorts and local schools.

Must Experience

Tanjung Pinang (Tanjungpinang) is the main town of Bintan Island and the capital of Riau Islands. Steeped with laid back and idyllic charm, Tanjung Pinang offers great insights to Bintan's local culture, history and heritage.







Tanjung Pinang Traditional Market

Take in the sights and smells as you maneuver the wet markets with stalls selling an amazing variety of meats, fresh vegetables and vibrant tropical fruits stacked high on wooden carts.



The market sits above the sea with rows of fishmongers showcasing their freshest catch of the

day. Just around a corner of the meandering streets lies the **traditional market** where rows of shophouses offer a diverse range of products such as dried seafood, electronic goods, antique ceramics, colourful apparel, handicrafts amongst other souvenirs.





Tanjung Pinang City Centre

Tanjung Pinang City Center is the newest and biggest shopping mall in the town of Tanjung Pinang. Other than food and beverage, fashion, accessories, gadgets and entertainment options, the mall is also home to the city's only cinema (Cinema XXI). It has three levels of retail shops and a Hypermart in the basement. One of the Indonesia's mustbuys—Kueh Lapis can be found here.

3 Vihara Ksitigarbha Bodhisattva (500 Lohan Temple)



Located in **South Bintan**, a short drive away from the main bustling scene of **Tanjung Pinang**, **Vihara Ksitigarbha Bodhisattva (500 Lohan Temple)** is one of Bintan's best hidden treasures.

Step into the temple grounds and stroll through towering structures towards more than 500 intricate life-sized arhat stone statues, each one unique and different from the next. Marvel at the sight before you and try spotting famous characters such as Journey to the West's Tripitaka or Romance of the Three Kingdoms' Guan Gong.



Vihara Avalokitesvara Graha (Guan Yin Temple)



Vihara Avalokitesvara Graha (Guan Yin Temple) is home to one of the tallest statues of the Goddess of Mercy in Southeast Asia. Sitting 16.8m tall, the majestic brass statue is coated in 22-karat gold.

Explore the tranquil temple grounds and marvel at



5 Senggarang Village





Senggarang Village is a respite from the hectic city centre, just a 45-minute drive or a short 15-minute water taxi ride from Tanjung Pinang. Believed to be the first Chinese settlement in Bintan, Senggarang Village is home to some of the island's oldest temples.

Two of Senggarang's most famed landmarks are the Lau Ya Keng temple complex and a 200-yearold Banyan Tree Temple.

Built to give thanks for success in business, safe sea passage and bountiful harvests, Lau Ya Keng is home to a trio of traditional Chinese temples dedicated to the Supreme Emperor of Dark Heaven, Goddess of the Sea and God of Prosperitu, right in front of the jettu.

Witness the power of Mother Nature at **Banyan Tree Temple** where ancient trees roots entwine and envelop walls of the temple building in protective embrace. The result is a fascinating and formidable structure that makes an ideal photography subject.



6 Penyengat Island

An offshore island from the main capital of **Tanjung Pinang**,

Pulau Penyengat is known as the abode of the kings as the central seat of power during the final phase of the Malay kingdom. Embark on a journey

back to the reign of Kings and Queens who once ruled the islands of the Riau Kingdom on a pompong (small motorised boat).





Hop onto a becak (motorised trishaw) to explore palace ruins, royal mausoleums and other sites from a bygone Riau-Lingga sultanate era with heavy Malay cultural and historical significance.

The tour brings you to various burial sites of historical figures that are buried on the island - Raja Hamildah, Raja Haji Fisabilillah and Raja Ali Haji.



Did you know? Raja Hamidah was the Queen of Bintan. Raja Haji Fisabilillah is a National Hero of Indonesia with Bintan's airport named after him. Raja Ali Haji was a scholar and the first authoritative lexicographer of the Malay language, whose other great works include Gurindam Dua Belas and Tuhfat al-Nafis.

Sitting regally in hues of royal yellow and green, Masjid Raya Sultan Riau (Sultan of Riau's Grand Mosque) was built in the 18th century.

The bonding agent used for the mosque's construction is rumoured to be egg whites received as gifts during the

Sultan's wedding. Known as the "Jewel of the Island", the mosque is also home to a rare 150-year old handwritten Quran.

Awarded the 'Certificate of Excellence' by TripAdvisor, the island along with all its attractions, pending listing as UNESCO World Heritage Sites.





Due to the inviolable sanctity of **Pulau Penyengat**, visitors are advised to dress conservatively.

Located right at the edge of Tanjung Pinang's morning markets, Bintan Indah Mall houses a small coffee shop with a variety of local dishes. Our recommendation is to try out the famous chicken wanton mee!

Visit the trusted brand of **Sederhana Masakan Padang** for a taste of Indonesia's
Nasi Padang! Served in authentic 'hidang'
style where dishes are laid out in a spread,
customers pay only for dishes they ate.

Found right opposite the local landmark, **Gedung Gonggong**, pick from an array of flavourful dishes including Rendang Daging, Asam Padeh and Dendeng Balado, and satisfy your tastebuds!







Just a stone's throw away, The Manabu sits perched on a hill with a beautiful view overlooking Pulau Penyengat. Serving a wide variety of dishes such as Asian fusion cuisine, western cuisine and many local dishes with a twist, it is no wonder that The Manabu is a hot local favourite.

Tip: Arrive before golden hour to catch the best seats in the house for a brilliant sunset view!





Local dishes

Tape

Tape (ta-peh) or Tapai (ta-pie) is fermented tapioca wrapped in banana leaf. It has an interesting rum taste that is sweet and slightly sour, with texture like the durian, the regionally well-known 'King of Fruits'. This local delight can only be found in Bintan.

Ayam Penyet

Ayam Penyet is another Indonesian specialty which cannot be missed. Chicken meat is fried crisp to a deep golden brown and smashed with a pestle againsts mortar, making it softer. It is usually served with slices of cucumber, fried tofu, tempeh and spicy sambal chilli for that extra kick.



3 Night Markets

Rimba Jaya is one of the best hangout spots in Tanjung Pinang after the sun sets. Go on an empty stomach! The area plays host to a night market, hawker centre, hipster cafes, a bar and even an authentic Japanese restaurant.

Take your tastebuds on an adventure at **Cangkir Hawker Centre** with rows of food stalls serving savoury local delights such as oyster omelette, Bak Kut Teh, Ikan and Seafood Bakar, Char Kway Teow, Satay and more.











Head over to **Tomo Japanese Restaurant** for authentic Japanese and Korean cuisines at affordable prices. After dinner, take a stroll along the night market selling food, toys, clothes and cosmetics. For dessert, look out for the famed Pisang Goreng Keju.

For a place to sit and simply enjoy the night scene, head to Loco Cafe, a two-storey container café that serves Taiwanese-style ice concoctions. The cafe is also a great place to watch the sunset with friends and family.

Recently refurbished, **The Canopy Cafe** will be ideal for friends
looking to chill over gourmet coffee
while taking Instagram-worthy
pictures against the colourful
murals.

Functioning as a carpark in the day, **Akau Potong Lembu** sees a stream of hawkers pushing in their food carts in the late afternoon and transforms into an open-air hawker centre at night. It is popular amongst natives of **Tanjung Pinang** for its cheap and delicious local fare.

Highly recommended by the locals, the fish soup and the famous Ice Chendol here is a must try!



Central Bintan

Gunung Bintan. Standing at 340m, the island's
highest summit. While ascending to the peak,
be surrounded by gigantic ancient trees and
soak in the dense tropical rainforest. **Gunung Bintan**is home to many wildlife such as silver-leaf monkeys,
sun birds and more.

Be rewarded with an awe-inspiring 360-view of the island at the top. Upon descending, look out for a small waterfall named "Kolam Puteri" or Princess's Pool and take a dip! According to a local legend, a dip in the princess's pool brings you good luck.

Must Eat




Ayam Presto Bude Nino

With small hills of sand-dunes mimicking a mini desert and clear turquoise lakes formed by rainfall over the years, this is the place you should not miss for insta-worthy photo spots!






3 TRC Mangrove Bintan

Yet another hidden gem to be discovered on the way to **Tanjung Uban** is **TRC Mangrove Bintan**. For a small admission fee, experience the mangrove forest tour and be awed as you pass through the rustic main gate, resembling

Jurassic Park's iconic gates. Capture picture perfect moments on the beach or amongst the dense mangroves.



Built with bricks many years ago, **Rumah Arang** consists of two igloo-shaped brick charcoal kilns. In the past, Bintan used to produce and export charcoal regionally. About 20 years ago, burning of manarove trees for charcoal was banned, and the



of mangrove trees for charcoal was banned, and the charcoal kilns are preserved to conserve the island's history and culture.



5 Vihara Guan Di Gong (Guan Gong Temple)

At Vihara Guan Di Gong, the Chinese God of War (Guan Sheng Di Jun) guards the temple at more than 16 meters tall. Said to be blessed and sacred, a Giant Turtle God Statue sits right opposite the temple looking after fishermen and seafaring merchants, and providing them a safe and smooth journey.

Discover Bahasa Indonesia
